6. COMPETITION FORMULA

Competition Method:

8-10 teams (one from each EEVZA Member federation) - are divided in two pools taking into account CEV Federations Ranking, i.e four/five teams in each pool. After Pool play teams follow play-off games according to the system: A1 vs B1 (for 1st Place); A2 vs B2 (for 3rd place); A3 vs B3 (for 5th place); A4 vs B4 (for 7th place), A5 vs B5 (for 9th place).

Allocation of points (CEV Official Regulations, Article 2, Art.2.2.):

2.2.1. For all the rounds of the EEVZA Championships, the allocation of points shall be as follows:

2.2.2 EEVZA competition standing is based on the number of matches won.







Points for won and lost matches are allocated as follows:

- Winner 3:0 or 3:1 3 points
- Winner 3:2 2 points
- Loser 2:3 1 point
- Loser 1:3 or 0:3 0 point

2.2.3. There is a tie between teams, when each team has the same number of matches won.

In case of tie, the standing of the Participants is established by using the following criteria in the following mentioned order, until the tie ends:

- In descending order by the number of allocated points for won and lost matches,

- In descending order by the set quotient resulting from the division of all sets won by all sets lost

during the competition,

- In descending order by the set points quotient resulting from the division of all set points scored by all sets points lost during the competition,

- In descending order by the result(s) of the match(es) played between them

2.2.4 Forfeit is imposed as foreseen in the Official Volleyball Rules, the FIVB Sports Regulations or CEV Official Regulations.

2.2.5 Any team refusing to play a match shall be sanctioned according to the CEV Code of Discipline. The results obtained up to the moment of its exclusion shall be cancelled.

2.2.6 A match will be accounted for as lost by 0-3 (0-25; 0-25; 0-25) by the team concerned:

□ If a doping rule violation occurs

If one or more players are not eligible as per the provisions of these Regulations.

2.2.7 A team refusing to play against another team shall be excluded from the rest of the EEVZA AGE Championships. The results obtained up to the moment of its exclusion shall be cancelled. As of the time of exclusion, all further expenses incurred shall be borne by the defaulting team.

8. MEDICAL SERVICES AND CONTROL

All players are obliged to present during the Preliminary Inquiry a Health Certificate – issued date December 2016.

The organizer will provide first aid in the competition hall. All other medical services should be paid in accordance with the Rules of the Polish medical service.

9. OFFICIAL VOLLEYBALL RULES AND BALLS

The competition shall be played in accordance with the FIVB Volleyball Rules of the Game in force. All necessary interpretations will be done before the competitions during the Preliminary Inquiry.

The only Ball to be used for all matches is the MIKASA MVA -200.

10. FINANCIAL MATTERS

EXPENSES COVERED BY THE ORGANIZER

The board and lodging costs for 20 persons (14 players, 5 officials + 1 referee) per team;

Laundry of 14 sets of uniforms (1 pair of socks, 1 t-shirt and 1 pair of shorts) during match days;

Medical care;

Organizer will provide a cup, team Diploma and 19 gold medals for the EEVZA Champion and teams classified 2nd and 3rd will receive 19 medals per each team, respectively silver and bronze. All prizes will be given during the closing ceremony which will be conducted 30 minutes after gold medal match.

Each delegation shall bear the following costs:

International transportation to the official venue of arrival and departure and back;

Contribution to the board and lodging amounting to 50 EURO per person per day;







The arrival and departure day is counting as 1 (one) full day;

Board and lodging of the extra persons/days amounting 100,00 EURO per person per day.
